## GIRLS PREMIER 5 PIECE NATIONALS

### Eligibility:

All teams except U9 entered by the closing date will automatically qualify unless more than 12 teams enter in U15 and more than 16 teams enter in U10, U11 U13 and O13 age groups.

\*12 team places only available for the U9 and U15 categories.

\*16 team places available for U10, U11, U13 & O13 categories.

**Under 9s** - no one gains automatic qualification - all must attend 2 Piece competition to gain a place.

**Under 10s** - top 6 teams in the preceding academic year's U9 Nationals secure a place for U10 Nationals, if the schools wish to enter. Everyone else must qualify for the remaining available places.

**Under 11s** - top 10 teams in the preceding academic year's U10 Nationals secure a place for U11 Nationals, if the schools wish to enter. Everyone else must qualify for the remaining available places.

**Under 13s** - top 10 teams in the preceding academic year's U13 Nationals secure a place for U13 Nationals, if the schools wish to enter. Everyone else must qualify for the remaining available places.

**Under 15s** - top 6 teams in preceding academic year's U15 Nationals secure a place for U15 Nationals, if the schools wish to enter. Everyone else must qualify for the remaining available places.

**Over 13s** - top 10 teams in preceding academic year's O13 Nationals secure a place for O13 Nationals, if the schools wish to enter. Everyone else must qualify for the remaining available places.

- I understand that I can qualify for a place if pre-eligibility does not work in my favour, Qualification takes place at the 2 Piece Competition at Stamford Endowed Junior School on 10-11 November 2018.
- I understand that my entry money will be refunded if I am unsuccessful in gaining a place in the Premier 5 Piece Nationals.
- If my team is unsuccessful in gaining a place in this competition I could enter them in the 4 Piece Girls Challenge Cup Nationals. The entry deadline for this competition is **Monday 19 November 2018**.
- I appreciate that for my entry to be accepted it must be accompanied by a valid affiliation number. This is only issued by the Administrator after the annual affiliation fee has been paid by my school.
- Restrictions: A school may only enter one team per age group. 'B' teams are not eligible.
- **Insurance:** By entering this event, you confirm that your school has insurance in place to cover pupils, staff, volunteers and anybody else representing your school at this event. I.S.G.A. does not carry insurance to cover anybody representing your school at this event.
- **Photography:** Official professional photographer/s will be invited to attend the championships, which by its very nature, is in the public arena. When entering for the event the schools, parents and participants acknowledge this fact, which may result in the recording of his/ her image. Their professional equipment is designed to take action shots without flashlight. The contact prints are displayed and can be selected, printed and purchased at the event. If any parents do not wish their child to be photographed, ie at the Presentation, it is left to individual schools to ensure that the child is removed before team photos are taken. ISGA and the Host organisers cannot take responsibility for this. There will be a camera register which has to be signed by all spectators and staff if they intend to take photos on a camera, video or mobile device. **No flash photography is allowed during the competition by spectators as this is dangerous for the gymnasts.** ISGA officials may also take photos of the Presentation etc.
