

ISGA Assistant Judging Course 2023

The ISGA Assistant judging course this year will involve 3 Zoom meetings over 3 consecutive evenings, each an hour long and a practical session of 4 hours on the following Sunday morning.

This is a triple purpose course.

- 1 **GAIN MORE KNOWLEDGE:** For all coaches, teachers or assistants who would like to gain more knowledge as to how the ISGA routines, vaults and groups are judged.
- 2 **BECOME AN ISGA ASSISTANT JUDGE:** For all coaches, teachers, parents or gymnasts (minimum age 14 years) who would like to become an ISGA Assistant Judge. This will enable them to assist an experienced judge at ISGA competitions.
- 3 **A JUDGES REFRESHER COURSE:** For all current qualified judges.

All candidates will receive an ISGA Assistant Judging Certificate. Current ISGA judges will receive an ISGA Refresher Judges Course certificate.

DATES FOR THE COURSE:

- **Zoom 1** – Monday 18 September, 8.30 – 9.30p.m.: Introduction to judging and Set Floor.
- **Zoom 2** – Tuesday 19 September, 8.30 – 9.30pm: Voluntary floor and Group
- **Zoom 3** – Wednesday 20 September, 8.30 – 9.30pm: Set and Voluntary Vault.

In person course – Sunday 24 September, 9.30am – 1.30pm. At Haberdashers' Boys' School, Butterfly Lane, Elstree, Radlett, Borehamwood WD6 3AF

The practical session on the Sunday will involve live gymnasts. Towards the end of this session all candidates will have the opportunity to practice their judging and then discuss their scores afterwards. This will not be a formal exam. Before the first zoom course, all candidates will be emailed the ISGA rules and judging symbols for them to learn in preparation for the course.

This course will be delivered by the ISGA Technical team, which includes myself and:

Mrs Suzanne Rimini: The ISGA General Administrator (General Secretary and Treasurer), BG Women's Artistic Level 2 Coach and a BG Women's Artistic Club Judge.
