NOTES FOR GIRLS PREMIER 5 PIECE NATIONALS

Eligibility: Eligibility criteria have changed for certain age groups. Please see attached table, *Eligibility for ISGA 2 Piece 2024 and 4 Piece and 5 Piece 2025*

- I understand that I can qualify for a place if pre-eligibility does not work in my favour, Qualification takes place at the 2 Piece Competition at Haberdashers' Boys' School on Sunday 24 November 2024. The deadline for that competition is **Friday 4 October 2024**.
- I understand that my entry money will be refunded if I am unsuccessful in gaining a place in the Premier 5 Piece Nationals.
- If my team is unsuccessful in gaining a place in this competition, I could enter them in the Girls 4 Piece Challenge Cup Nationals which will take place at Haberdashers' Boys' School on Saturday 8 February 2024 (U9s only). The entry deadline for this competition is also Friday 4 October 2024.
- I appreciate that for my entry to be accepted it must be accompanied by a valid affiliation number. This is only issued by the Administrator after the annual affiliation fee has been paid by my school.
- **Restrictions:** A school may only enter one team per age group. 'B' teams are not eligible.
- **Insurance:** By entering this event, you confirm that your school has insurance in place to cover pupils, staff, volunteers and anybody else representing your school at this event. ISGA does not carry insurance to cover anybody representing your school at this event.
- **Photography:** Official professional photographer/s will be invited to attend the championships, which by its very nature, is in the public arena. When entering for the event the schools, parents and participants acknowledge this fact, which may result in the recording of gymnasts' images. Their professional equipment is designed to take action shots without flashlight. The contact prints are displayed and can be selected, printed and purchased at the event. If any parents do not wish their child to be photographed, ie at the Presentation, it is left to individual schools to ensure that the child is removed before team photos are taken. ISGA and the Host organisers cannot take responsibility for this. There will be a camera register which has to be signed by all spectators and staff if they intend to take photos on a camera, video or mobile device. **No flash photography is allowed during the competition by spectators as this is dangerous for the gymnasts.** ISGA officials may also take photos of the Presentation and individual schools must notify ISGA, in writing, if gymnasts' photos should not appear on the Gallery section of the ISGA website
